Some things that are not acceptable:

- *taunting, trash talking and other intimidating actions.
- *yelling or waving arms during opponent's free throw.
- *disrespectful or derogatory yells, chants, songs or gestures.
- *booing or heckling officials about a call.
- *yells that antagonize opponents, name calling, being disrespectful.
- *blaming loss on someone else.
- *using inappropriate props.
- *doing own cheers instead of following cheerleaders.
- *use of profanity.
- *wearing extreme/unusual clothing or excessive face or body painting which detracts from the action on the playing surface.

The Michigan High School Athletic Association, of which we are a member, has spent the last several years campaigning for improved sportsmanship. What we see on TV makes it all the more difficult. Let's continue to work together to have the best Sportsmanship in the State!

SPORTSMANSHIP

We appreciate your continued support of our positive sportsmanship policies. Good sportsmanship improves the quality of the event and makes for a beneficial experience for the student/athlete. As we establish good sportsmanship habits we see many positive things happen: good citizenship, respect shown for opponents, officials, coaches, your own team, courteous and mannerly behavior, acknowledgement of good play, modesty and kindness, humbleness in victory, no excuses in defeat, the golden rule. It is not enough that sports are a part of education; they need to be a good part! Sportsmanship plays an important role!

Some things that are acceptable of spectators in general:

- *remember that you are at a contest to support and yell for your team and to enjoy the skill and competition; not to intimidate or ridicule the other team and its fans.
- *remember that school athletics are learning experiences for students and that mistakes are sometimes made.
- *show respect for the opposing players, coaches, spectators and support groups. Treat them as you would treat a guest in your own home.

Some things that are acceptable:

- *applause during introduction for all players, coaches and officials.
 - *accepting all decisions by the officials.
 - *positive cheering in a positive fashion.
 - *hand shakes between competitors.
- * being quiet during a free throw attempt or volleyball serve, etc.
- * showing concern for the injured player.

Student Advisory Council Belief Statement

Adopted Nov. 2007

As the voice of Michigan's student-athletes, the Student Advisory Council's role is to convey the message of how high school sports are supposed to be played. We are responsible for helping the MHSAA maintain a positive and healthy atmosphere in which interscholastic athletes can thrive.

*We believe **athletes** should be competitive, sportsmanlike and excel academically. We believe **students** in the stands should have fun, but not take the focus away from the game. We believe **coaches** should act as teachers, helping student-athletes develop while still keeping high school sports in perspective. We believe that **parents** should always be positive role models and be supportive of their child's decisions. We believe **officials** commit their own time to high school sports and respect should always be shown and given to them.*

The most important goal for student-athletes is to enjoy high school sports while keeping a high level of respect between all those involved in the games.
