YOUNG FIVES

- 1 regular backpack, labeled with student's name
- 1 large box facial tissue (do not label)
- 2-boxes of 24 Crayola crayons
- 2-pkgs markers
- 1- pkg colored pencils
- 2-4-oz Elmer's Glue
- 2-Large glue sticks
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer
- 1 - box jumbo 2.5 gallon ziploc bags
- 1 spiral bound notebook (for journal)
- 1 antibacterial wipes (Clorox, etc.)

KINDERGARTEN

- 1 regular backpack, labeled with student's name
- 1 antibacterial wipes (Clorox, etc.)
- 1 spiral notebook (plain with no pictures)
- 3 – 2-pocket folders (plain with no pictures)
- 1 large box facial tissue (do not label)
- 1 package paper cups
- 1 pair scissors (Fiskars recommended)-OPTIONAL
- 1 - pkg dry erase markers
- 1 box of 16 or 24 Crayola crayons
- 1 - pkg of 8 Crayola markers
- 1 - pkg #2 pencils
- Large eraser
- 1 - Large bottle hand sanitizer
- 1 - pkg glue sticks
- 1 - pkg of napkins
- 1 - box jumbo 2.5 gallon ziploc bags
- And ONE of the FOLLOWING:*
- 1 box of ziploc storage bags gallon size **OR**
- 1 box of ziploc storage bags, sandwich size **OR**

GRADE 1

- 1 regular backpack, labeled with student's name
- 1 box of 24 Crayola crayons
- 24 #2 sharpened pencils with erasers (label)
- 2 pink pearl erasers
- 1 pair metal scissors (Fiskars recommended)

- 2- 4-oz bottle white glue
- 1 box of colored pencils (optional)
- 1 plastic pencil box
- 1 large box facial tissue (do not label)
- 8 pack of markers
- 1 box gallon-sized zipper bags (do not label)
- 1 box sandwich-sized zipper bags (do not label)

GRADE 2

- 1 regular backpack, labeled with student's name
- 1 box of 24 Crayola crayons
- 24 #2 sharpened pencils with erasers (label)
- 2 big erasers, preferably white
- 1 pr of metal pointed scissors (Fiskars recommended)
- 1 bottle white glue and glue sticks
- 1 spiral notebook (wide ruled)
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer
- 1 box colored pencils
- 2 large boxes facial tissue
- 1 box sandwich Ziploc bags
- 1 box gallon-sized zipper bags (do not label)-OPTIONAL

GRADE 3

- 1 small package of wide-lined notebook paper
- Glue
- 1 package #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils, please)
- Erasers
- Small pencil sharpener
- Crayons-box of 24 or less
- Box of 12 colored pencils
- Wooden 12" ruler (inches and centimeters)
- Scissors (Fiskars recommended)
- 3-2-pocket folders
- Small plastic pencil box or zipper pouch
- 2 red ink pens
- Wide ruled spiral bound notebook
- Yellow highlighter
- Large box of tissue
- Non-marking sole tennis shoes for gym
- Water bottle with squirt-type top
- \$3.00 donation for the assembly fund
- \$3.00 for purchase of class t-shirt, which the child will keep at the end of the year

Teacher notes: We suggest an eye exam before entering 3rd grade. It is extremely important that each child has his/her own supplies. Please label supplies with your child's name.

GRADE 4

- Wide-lined notebook paper
- #2 pencils (3 to start)
- Eraser
- Crayons (box of 16 or more)
- Scissors (Fiskars Recommended)
- Large box of tissue
- 2-pocket folders (2)
- Ink pen (blue or black)
- \$3.00 donation for the assembly fund
- Glue stick or small bottle of glue
- Colored pencils
- Wooden 12" ruler (inches and centimeters)-OPTIONAL
- Markers-OPTIONAL

GRADE 5

- Wide rule notebook paper
- #2 pencils (3 or more)—no mechanical pencils please as they often become toys for students
- Red ink pens
- Three bound notebooks (70-80 pages each)-no multi-subject notebooks
- Scissors
- Colored pencils
- Small plastic pencil or storage box
- 4-two pocket folders
- Glue stick or small bottle of glue
- Water-based markers and/or small box of crayons
- Yellow highlighter
- Eraser
- Large box of tissue
- Hand-held pencil sharpener with shavings catcher
- 12-inch ruler (inches and metric)
- Roll of tape (optional)
